WELLNESS NURSE PRACTITIONER

- · Serves as the patient/employee advocate and health system navigator for those employees who elect to participate in the Wellness Program and are identified with high risk/chronic health issues through the Health Risk Assessments (HRAs) and annual wellness evaluations
- Works with these patients to identify medium to long range goals for health improvement (exercise, weight loss, etc.)
- Performs annual wellness evaluations
- · Coordinates goals with patient's primary care physician or specialist, as needed
- · Provides intensive follow-up thereby increasing the rate of patient compliance and success
- Provides patient guidance for the most efficient and best quality care
- Tracks, measures and reports outcomes to identify further improvements
- · Provides fitness training and nutritional counseling


