The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the “Ocean Terminal Gate Renovation Package”.

The proposed work consists of providing all materials, equipment, and labor required to renovate existing terminal areas including truck gates, a reefer service area, and a reefer washdown area. Renovation will consist of demolition and removal of existing pavements and utilities, installing approximately 36 acres of pavements, grading, drainage, utilities, high-mast lighting, inbound and outbound gates with canopies, pavement markings, and other ancillary items as required to complete the work. The majority of the project will occur on a previously constructed subgrade. The project is located at the Ocean Terminal, Savannah, Georgia.

Bids for proposed work will be received up to **3:00 P.M., December 17, 2024**. The bid opening will be public.
