The Georgia Ports Authority will receive sealed bids for the “Colonel’s Island Terminal Berth 4” project. Bids for proposed work will be received up to **2:00 P.M., April 24, 2025**. The bid opening will be public.

The proposed work consists of two major components: the construction of the proposed Berth 4, a new Roll-on/Roll-off (Ro/Ro) berth with heavy cargo capability, and the construction of upgrades to the landward portion of the existing Berth 1 structure. The primary elements of the new Berth 4 include a pile supported main pier, a pile-supported dock approachway connected to Joe Frank Harris Blvd, a pile supported heavy lift connector bridge between Berth 4 and Berth 1, associated mooring and breasting structures, and new-work berth dredging and associated wetland mitigation. The upgrades to Berth 1 include demolition, disposal, and upgrade of a portion of the existing berth structure to accommodate new operational requirements. The project is located at the Georgia Ports Authority’s Colonel’s Island Terminal, Glynn County, Georgia.

Bids must be accompanied by a bid security equal to 10 percent of the bid sum. If a construction contract is awarded, the successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each equal in amount to contract sum.

Bidders are invited to attend a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting that will convene at 10:00 A.M., March 12, 2025, at the GPA’s Mayor’s Point Terminal Administrative office, located at 100 Gloucester Street, Brunswick, GA 31520. Bidders will have an opportunity to conduct an examination of the project site after the pre-bid meeting.
